





HOMEWORK TROUBLE-SHOOTER

How can I support a student with LDs who is not completing their homework?

Use the decision tree below to help identify issues and solutions when a student struggles to complete their homework. It is based on a series of questions that educators can ask themselves in order to identify the difficulty observed in the student. Depending on the answer to the question, the tree will then suggest possible steps or interventions the educator can apply in order to support the student in their learning.

Give constructive, non-judgemental feedback
(aim for two positive comments to each negative).
Gamify fixing mistakes (ie. Can you find the 7
misspelled words on this page?).
Discuss mistakes that are due to a lack
of understanding (rather than carelessness).
Clarify the expectations and consequences
for poor quality work.

to remain motivated while
completing homework?

Convey to students that homework is important and
a responsibility that they should take seriously.
Consider an incentive for homework completion.
